In-Home Personal Support

Personal care is provided by certified Personal Support Workers. Services offered through CCAC and or may also be purchased privately.

Home Help

Help with household chores, errands, shopping, laundry and daily tasks.

Reassurance

Volunteer checks - regularly in person or by telephone to ensure all is well. Lifeline - an easy-to-use personal 24 hour emergency response service.

Home at Last (HAL)

Helps aging adults and those with special needs to settle in at home safely and comfortably after a stay in hospital.

Respite

Provides care when family needs a break. Overnight Respite available at Adult Day Centres for specific needs.

Dining/Social Programs

Hot meals and special events or activities help people to get together for good food and companionship.

Exercise

Community group or in-home exercise activities designed to increase physical strength, stamina and well being and reduce falls.
