

ONE CARE Board Highlights – January 29, 2019

The ONE CARE Board of Directors held a Board Meeting on January 29, 2019 via OTN Video Conference between the Clinton and Stratford ONE CARE offices.

Meeting Highlights:

- The Board accepted the Strategic Monitoring Report which monitors the impact of PSW shortages.
- The Board approved a language revision to the Strategic Plan.
- The Board updated the Risk Management Plan to reflect current risks and mitigation strategies.
- The Board reviewed the results of their PESTLE Analysis, and identified key issues to be tracked administratively as well as through the Board's Environmental Scan.
- The Board received an update on local and regional health system committees attended by the Executive Director and agreed on reporting for these and other health system changes going forward.
- The Board had a discussion on the United Way's work on transportation services and the involvement of ONE CARE.
- The Board had a discussion on engagement of past Board members.
- The Board accepted a report on this year's CAPS Narrative submission to the LHIN, including a summary overview of ONE CARE's Programs and Services.
- The Board accepted the Human Resources Report and Plan.
- The Board accepted a report on a change in reporting of the Client and Caregiver Experience Evaluation (CCEE) results.
- The Board accepted a report from the Governance-Nominating Committee, including policy revisions.
- The Board accepted a report from the Vehicle Working Group, formally disbanding the working group.
