Assistive Devices Program (ADP) during COVID-19

The Assisted Devices Program provides support and funding to Ontario residents who have long-term physical disabilities and who need access to personalized assistive devices appropriate for their needs.

As a result of the COVID-19 outbreak, the Assisted Devices Program is now accepting all new applications for funding assistance via email (for grants) and fax (for devices). (Any applications that were previously submitted by regular mail are being processed and do not need to be resubmitted.)

Applications can be submitted from eligible Ontarians for:

- Breast Prothesis
- Enteral Feeding Pumps and Supplies
- Insulin Pumps and Supplies for Adults and Children
- Insulin Syringes for Seniors
- Ostomy Grants
- Respiratory Equipment & Supplies
