Meet with hiring employers and receive a conditional job offer as a Supportive Care Worker prior to starting training.

In as little as 18-weeks, you will be prepared for careers as caregivers in the Home & Community Healthcare sector.

This program prepares you to assist individuals needing support to live independently in the home or community. You will develop a clear understanding of your role as a member of the healthcare team and how you can add real value to the healthcare system and positively influence the lives of others.

Training includes:

- Three industry recognized certificates
- 80-hour, on-the-job practicum
- A conditional job offer as a Supportive Care Worker based upon successful completion of the program
- A pathway to a career as a Personal Support Worker
- Conestoga College Certificate

Program eligibility:

- Participants must meet program admission requirements
- Participants must meet employer occupation requirements
- Eligibility requirements will be discussed in detail during information sessions
